



SERRADELLA (*ORNITHOPUS SATIVUS*)

› Serradella is an annual legume characterized by a strongly branched root system and the formation of a dense green cover. It is suitable for stubble sowing as green manure or for forage use as pure or mixed seed.

› Valuable legume summer intercrop for sandy soils of fresh and partly dry locations. Provides good arable grazing in forage-poor periods and improves soil fertility. In Germany, it is the only form of cultivated serradella that has been subjected to conservation breeding and is selected for diseases.
